## **Vaccinations:**

## **Physical Distancing & Masks:**

The consensus from leading health authorities is that outdoor activities are in general safe as long as people practice physical distancing while they interact. If you've been to the Shire, our wide open spaces makes this practice relatively easy. We'll be encouraging our campers to imagine themselves as bubbles of life and joy—form and potential—within the full sweep of their outstretched arms. Short of giving everyone a yard stick, this will give campers a personal point of reference to enhance spatial awareness while interacting with others. There are a few project activities that could bring us into closer proximity which is why we'll expect everyone to have a mask on hand throughout the camp day. This will be especially important if we have a rain or storm incident requiring us to shelter in the house garage and porch. Both of these areas will be set up for such times if occasion requires.

## **Cleaning Station:**

Throughout the course of a camp day, we'll make regular visits to an outdoor washing table set up for hand cleaning. Here also we'll disinfect gear and equipment used during the camp day.

## **Bathroom:**

The Nowhere house will have a reserved bathroom for camper use, accessed through the back of the house. Serving one camper at a time, we'll have a flag to signal when its occupied.

## **Mealtime:**

As much as we love to share food, this summer we're discouraging this among campers. Everyone should bring their own food and beverage.

## **Your part:**

First of all please go through these elements with your kids before the camp week, explaining the rationale behind them and addressing any related questions that arise. We ask that you check your kid's over heath temper every camp morning, including their temperature. They will retain agency here and at any point that they're not feeling well, we ask that you'll be available for a pickup if required.
